Charging Policy

Educational Visits

Educational visits are arranged throughout the year. These visits, which are usually related to a class project, are beneficial, worthwhile and form part of the curriculum.

In accordance with current legislation, the school cannot make compulsory charges for educational visits which take place during school hours. However, to help school funds go further, the school may ask for a voluntary contribution from parents of up to a maximum of £12.50 towards the cost of the visit. We understand that in some instances a child's parents are unable to make this contribution and the school will always be sympathetic to this. No child will be excluded from the visit because a voluntary contribution has not been made. If, however, too few parents agree to contribute towards a particular visit, and funds cannot be sourced from elsewhere, it may have to be cancelled.

No charges made will exceed the actual cost of any activity.

Sunrisers Before School Breakfast Club

The School runs a before school breakfast club called Sunrisers. This starts at 7.45am and finishes at 8.45am. The charge for attendance is currently £3 per child for each attendance.
