## Sport Funding Plans

Our allocation for Sports Funding for the academic year 2016/17 is expected to be £8375.00 and will be added to our carried forward of £2780 from 2015/16.

Our aims for the use of Sports Funding:

- Staff development training in Dance, Games and Gymnastics
- To increase fitness levels for all pupils
- To increase skill levels in PE
- To enable pupils to have the opportunity to try a range of sports and sporting activities in order to stimulate their interest and enthusiasm in PE
- Purchase of PE and sport equipment
- Specialist sport coaches to deliver high quality sport sessions for pupils
